Application Form

Please provide **three** copies of each of the following:

- Completed application form
- A one page cover letter summarising your residency objectives, proposed arrival date and intentions during your time in China
- A project proposal demonstrating what you would like to do while in China and outlining your specific artistic rationale for wanting to be resident in China
- Details of the programme of talks and/or exhibitions you plan to undertake on your return to New Zealand
- Your CV, outlining artistic accomplishments, awards, exhibitions, published work etc.
- Three letters of support from industry professionals
- A list of equipment needs, clearly indicating what you will provide and what you will need to source in Beijing
- At least six examples of your most recent work and a link to your website if you have one. (Do not send originals. Copies on CD or DVD will be accepted but please send three copies)
- Copies of recent articles, reviews, and catalogues.

All support materials submitted must be clearly labelled with your name.

Applications should **reach** Asia New Zealand Foundation **BY NO LATER THAN 5pm Friday 31 July**. Late applications will not be considered.
